Pullorum School Requirements

The Ohio Poultry Association (official state agency, NPIP) and the Ohio Department of Agriculture are combining efforts to organize Pullorum-Fowl Typhoid plate agglutination tester training classes. Whether your certification is due to expire or you have expressed interest in becoming a newly certified Pullorum tester, we are inviting you to participate in the training program. You must be 18 years of age to become a certified tester.

There is a charge of \$50 per student to offset program costs. There is an additional \$5 fee for first time participants. Your certification is valid for 5 years. If your certification is due to expire in 2017, you will need to attend this training to maintain certification. If this is your first time being certified, you will physically test a bird, A BIRD WILL BE PROVIDED FOR YOU. DO NOT BRING ANY POULTRY TO THE CLASS. Each person needs to please <u>bring a lawn chair</u> to class as chairs will not be provided.

Pullorum Testing Equipment

Dependent on availability, the Ohio Poultry Association will sell Antigen in 10 ml (approximately 200 tests) bottles for \$40.00 each on the day of the class. Please indicate on your registration if intending to purchase. If you are interested in purchasing the 50 ml (approximately 1000 tests) bottle you may order it directly from: Twin City Supply – 614-595-8608. Information on where to purchase all other supplies (bleeders, needles, test boxes, testing plates, etc.) will be in the packets that will be provided at the tester training class.
