The Ohio 4-H Shooting Education Camp is a 6-day, fun-filled learning experience for boys and girls, ages 12 to 18. The activities planned are part of the camp program focusing on the safe, responsible, and ethical use of firearms and archery equipment.

Shooting instruction is led by certified and experienced 4-H Shooting Sports Instructors. Many of our instructors hold additional certification in related shooting organizations such as the National Rifle Association, National Archery Development Association, and the National Muzzleloading Rifle Association.

Each camper selects one shooting discipline as a specialty for the week. The majority of their shooting activities will be in this area (approximately 15 hours). Campers will also have the opportunity to sample additional shooting disciplines, learning under the direction of our trained instructors.
