May 4 —Does My Plant Have a Flu?

Do you have a sick pachysandra? Is your allium ailing? We'll get to the bottom of the science involved with plant viruses when you learn how to isolate the DNA from a plant and discover the difference between virus-infected and non-infected plants. Dr. Jelena Brkljadic from OSU's Arabidopsis Biological Resource Center and a team from ABRC and the plant virology lab will lead this exploration into plant science.

(P.S. You'll even find out if an "arabidopsis" is lurking near your house!)
