## What does this mean???



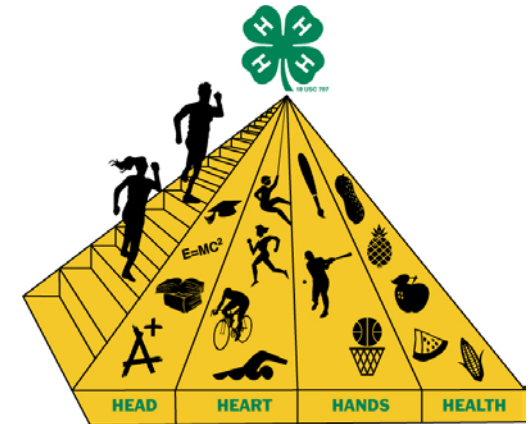
- ✿ The four H's stand for **Head, Heart, Hand, and Health**. All of which can be understood through the 4-H Pledge that follows.
