Ohio 4-H Space Adventure Camp

4-H Space Adventure Camp is planned for June 17-19, 2014, at Marietta College, Marietta, Ohio. The camp is designed for students who are currently in grades 5-7 and ages 11-13. They do not need to be current 4-H members in your county program. Participants will live on the Marietta College campus and explore the world of flight with the help of college faculty and trained 4-H camp counselors. It's three fun-filled days of rockets, computer simulations, hot air balloons and more. The cost of \$199 includes housing, meals, and all program materials. Financial assistance is available for those who qualify. Space is limited to 40 campers and is designed as a one-time experience.

Please note: Because of limited space, if your county wishes to send campers, in order to 'save a space' we will need the \$50 deposit per camper in order to hold the spot. By submitting the deposit, this will allow you time to decide who is attending from your county and to get all of the camper paperwork completed and returned to us.
