## Arrival Checklist for the 2023 Ohio State Fair Junior Horse Show

HORSES ARE NOT ALLOWED TO ARRIVE BEFORE 2:00pm on Sunday, July 16<sup>th</sup>!

DO NOT PUT YOUR HORSE OR EQUIPMENT IN A STALL THAT IS NOT ASSIGNED TO YOU! STALL ASSIGNMENTS WILL BE AVAILABLE ONLINE AT HORSE.OSU.EDU AND POSTED NEXT TO THE JUNIOR SHOW OFFICE. EXHIBITORS USING THE WRONG STALLS WILL BE REQUIRED TO REMOVED THEIR HORSES AND/OR EQUIPMENT, CLEAN THE STALLS, PAY A \$100 PENALTY FEE, AND MAY BE DISMISSED FROM THE SHOW.

## **SHOW OFFICE HOURS**

Sunday, July 16<sup>th</sup> between 4:00pm – 8:00pm Monday, July 17<sup>th</sup> through Thursday, July 20<sup>th</sup> between 7:00am - 9:00pm Friday, July 21<sup>st</sup> between 7:00am until 1 hour after the last class of the day

- ♠ Arrive through Gate 10 wait to be directed to an available unloading space behind or in front of the Gilligan Complex by the gate attendant or State Highway Patrol. Reminder: Stall assignments are available online at www.horse.osu.edu on the Calendar of Events -Junior Horse Show page.
- Quickly unload equipment and prepare stall for your horse.
- Unload horse and settle into stall.
- Move trailer to designated trailer parking lot in North Parking Lot. Remember that others are waiting with their trailers to unload their horses, too!
- Return to the Gilligan Complex to check-in.
- ▶ If you are showing a pony or small equine, regardless of the class(es) entered, you must bring your animal to be measured in the designated area next to the Junior Horse Show office located at the end of the green wall in the middle of Gilligan Complex.
- Check-in at the Junior Horse Show office. You will need to bring your signed medical release form and measurement card (only if showing a pony or small equine). At check-in, you will confirm the classes in which you are entered and receive your participation ribbon and exhibitor numbers.
- ➡ Bring your bridles and misc. tack (i.e. tie downs, martingales, cavessons) to the
  designated bit inspection area along the green wall for inspection and tagging. If a bit
  has not been inspected, approved and tagged, the exhibitor will not be allowed to show.
