The **Ohio 4-H Shooting Education Camp** is a weeklong, fun-filled learning experience for campers ages 9-12. Camp activities focus on the safe, responsible, ethical use of firearms and archery equipment.

Shooting instruction is led by trained, experienced 4-H Shooting Sports Instructors. Many of our instructors hold additional certification in related shooting organizations such as the National Rifle Association, USA Archery Association and National Muzzle Loading Rifle Association.

Each camper selects one shooting discipline as a specialty for the weekend. Most of their shooting activities will be in this area (approximately 10 hours). See specialties listed in this flyer.

In addition to their selected specialty, campers can sample additional shooting specialties during the camp. All shooting sports learning activities are conducted under the direct supervision of our 4-H trained instructors.
