

Indoor Air Quality

The Nationwide and Ohio Farm Bureau 4-H Center will help set the standard for indoor air quality at Ohio State University. The following strategies will or have been employed:

- Carbon dioxide monitors;
- Limit contamination of systems during the construction phase;
- Low-emitting VOC materials have been used for adhesives, sealants, paints, coatings, carpet, and composite wood material;
- Grates at main points of entry to the building installed to capture contaminates from entering the building;
- Rooms that would traditionally house contaminants (janitors closet) are vented separately;
- Daylight designed for 75% of occupied space; and
- Outside views designed for nearly 90% of regularly occupied spaces.
