D. KNOWLEDGE OF SUBJECT MATTER (25 pts)

Were the facts and information presented accurate?
Was there enough information concerning the subject?
Was the content appropriately related to horse industry?
Was there evidence of preparation as demonstrated by the amount and depth of information?

E. DELIVERY (25 pts)

Was/Were the presenter(s) neat and appropriately dressed?
Did the presenter(s) talk directly to and look at the audience?
Was the rate of speech consistent and appropriate (not too fast or too slow)?
Did the presenter(s) have good voice control and quality?
Did the presenter(s) seem relaxed and display enthusiasm while presenting?
Were words pronounced correctly?
If notes were used, was it done without detracting from the speech?
Did the presenter(s) seem to choose words at the time they were spoken as opposed to a memorized delivery?

F. CREDIT AND CONTENT (10 pts)

1. Was the information obtained from reputable and/or research-based sources?
2. Was the content appropriately related to the equine industry?
3. Was credit given to sources of information if appropriate?

G. QUESTIONS (10 pts)

1. Did the presenter(s) handle questions easily?
2. Was/Were the presenter(s) thoughtful in their responses?
3. Did the presenter(s) answer questions thoroughly and correctly?
