




## Dairy Cattle Project and Record Book (127)

#### **Food and Nutrition**




#### Kitchen Boss (476)

- Beginning level. State fair eligible.






#### Leadership

- For members 13 or older with at least two years of 4-H years experience.
- Advanced level. State fair eligible.

- Now built around topic areas that have their own state fair classes, self-determined projects are a way for members to explore topics that interest THEM.
