

## Water Efficiency



## Nationwide & Ohio Farm Bureau 4-H Center



It is important for facilities to employ strategies that reduce their reliance on water resources. The Nationwide & Ohio Farm Bureau 4-H Center has implemented three primary techniques to reduce water use by approximately 30% over a comparable facility. First, the facility has dual flush toilets in all restrooms which provide water conserving options for the user. Also, the men's restrooms have waterless urinals which are increasing in popularity in the United States. Many large facilities (i.e., airports and sporting venues) have already installed these systems. Storm water will be managed on-site to minimize erosion and environmental run-off concerns. Finally, all sinks are equipped with faucet sensors to reduce waste water.
