



Water Efficiency

Nationwide & Ohio Farm Bureau 4-H Center



It is important for facilities to employ strategies that reduce their reliance on water resources. The Nationwide & Ohio Farm Bureau 4-H Center has implemented three primary techniques to **reduce water use** by approximately **30%** over a comparable facility. First, the facility has **dual flush toilets** in all restrooms which provide water conserving options for the user. Also, the men's restrooms have **waterless urinals** which are increasing in popularity in the United States. Many large facilities (i.e., airports and sporting venues) have already installed these systems. Storm water will be managed on-site to minimize erosion and environmental run-off concerns. Finally, all sinks are equipped with **faucet sensors** to reduce waste water.
