AREAS TO BE EVALUATED*	MEETS EXPECTATIONS	COMMENTS
INTERVIEW Demonstrates knowledge of the Assistance Dog Organization from which youth is raising puppy. Can discuss process of getting puppy, expectations of Assistance Dog Organization, training requirements, age dog is returned for additional training, etc.		
RECORDS Has records showing training and care required by Assistance Dog Organization completed up to judging date. (These may be records from Organization or exhibitor's own records.)		
MEMBER'S APPEARANCE AND ATTITUDE Presents with appropriate dress; demonstrates courtesy, poise, and good sportsmanship.		
DOG'S APPEARANCE AND GROOMING Presents with evidence of overall good health and good grooming (pay special attention to eyes, coat, ears, teeth, and toenails); allows examination without resistance.		
DOG'S TRAINING TO DATE Handler is able to demonstrate <u>progress</u> toward Canine Good Citizen test exercises: 1. Accepting Friendly Stranger and Sitting Politely for Petting 2. Able to Walk on Loose Leash without continual pulling 3. Can Walk through a Crowd (2-3 people) 4. Can Sit, Down, Come when Called		

*A dog that snaps, bites or attempts to bite must be immediately excused from the judging area.

Exhibitors with Meets Expectation Ratings in all 5 Areas will receive a Gold Medal and an Achievement Award. Exhibitors earning Meets Expectation Ratings in 1 to 4 Areas will receive an Award. All exhibitors will receive participation ribbons.

****An exhibitor whose dog fouls the ring will receive a participation ribbon only. Judge must confer with show committee if award value differs.**
