Minor to Substantial Deduction 1-10 Points	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Repeat of station (maximum of 1 retry = 3-pt deduction) • Pylon/post knocked over (on Fig. 8, Spiral & Serpentine) • Lack of control • Lack of teamwork • Lack of briskness • Handler error • Loud command or intimidating signal • Excessive barking • Hitting the jump • Patting/Clapping in Excellent (per occurrence) 		
Substantial Deduction 6-10 Points	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Incorrectly performed station (Automatic 10-pt deduction) • Failure to complete the Stay Exercise (no retries allowed) • Failure of dog to go over jump in proper direction (no retries) • Luring/Pleading with dog • Lack of Natural Manner 		
Maximum Deduction 11 + Points	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Minimum requirements not met • Dog unmanageable or uncontrolled barking • Consistently tight lead • Eliminates in ring during judging** • Handler error • Station not attempted by handler (-25 points)
