

WHAT IS THE OHIO 4-H CLUB FOUNDATION?

The Foundation was established in 1946 as a part of The Ohio State University Development Fund. Contributions to the Development Fund can be designated for the 4-H Foundation. Contributions have come from 4-H Club members, other individuals, organizations, industries, and businesses. The contributed funds are deposited with the Treasurer of the State of Ohio where they are "preserved inviolate and undiminished" under provisions of the Constitution of Ohio.

Only the interest is used. The principal remains intact.

An Executive Council of the Foundation recommends how income from the Fund shall be expended. The Council includes professional Extension personnel, local volunteer 4-H advisors, and representatives of the general public.
