The **Ohio 4-H Shooting Education Camp** is a weekend, fun-filled learning experience for boys and girls, ages 9 through 12. The activities planned are part of the camp program focusing on the safe, responsible, ethical use of firearms and archery equipment.

Shooting instruction is led by trained, experienced 4-H Shooting Sports Instructors. Many of our instructors hold additional certification in related shooting organizations such as the National Rifle Association, USA Archery Association and National Muzzle Loading Rifle Association.

Each camper selects one shooting discipline as a specialty for the weekend. The majority of their shooting activities will be in this area (approximately 10 hours). Campers will also have the opportunity to sample additional shooting specialties, learning under the direction of our 4-H trained instructors.
