

Ohio 4-H Alumni Award Application

Description

This award is presented to a 4-H alumnus who has demonstrated distinctive achievement in career or service and can attribute part of their success to participating in 4-H.

Nomination and Selection Criteria

Any individual is eligible to receive the award who was a 4-H member for at least three years; and must be living at the time of selection.

Up to two recipients will be selected on a statewide basis and will be presented with their award at the Ohio 4-H Volunteer Recognition Luncheon.

Information to be included in application

1. An application cover sheet
2. A nominating statement limited to two typewritten, single spaced, 8-1/2" x 11" pages. This can be completed by the nominee or the nominator. This statement should give an overview of the nominee's achievement and excellence in their profession, service and leadership in community programs, and provide examples of how 4-H helped them in their success.
3. Attach two letters of reference.
4. No additional pages of information, photos, and/or news clippings should be included.

Award and Presentation Details

An "Award Announcement Letter" listing the award recipients, will be sent to County Extension Offices in early February. Extension professionals can then personally notify award recipients.

Award recipients will receive personal invitations to the Bob Evans Farms Ohio 4-H Volunteer Recognition Luncheon directly from the State 4-H Office in early February. Each award recipient will receive an award during the luncheon at the Ohio 4-H Conference.
