Show and tell the group how to play basketball.



Show and tell the group how to draw a house.



Show and tell the group how to tie a shoe.



Show and tell the group how to start a car.



Show and tell the group how to roll up a sleeping bag or fold a blanket.



Tell the group how to make a peanut butter and jelly sandwich.



Show and tell the group how to address an envelope.



Show and tell the group how to make a paper airplane.



Show and tell the group how to play Tic Tac Toe.



Show and tell the group how to find a project in the 4-H Family Guide.



Show and tell the group how to sing a simple song, such as “Itsy Bitsy Spider.”
