

Community Service Award Criteria

Description

This award recognizes 4-H volunteers (youth and adults) who have collaborated or cooperated with community or 4-H groups, or included them with their own 4-H club or unit, in conducting community service projects or activities.

Nomination and Selection Criteria

All adult 4-H volunteers (and their 4-H club members) are eligible who: 1) are a current 4-H volunteer at the time application is made; 2) have not received this award in the last 5 years; and 3) have successfully undertaken a service activity which benefited and positively impacted an individual, group or community.

Up to three recipients will be selected statewide and will be presented with their award at the Ohio 4-H Volunteer Recognition Luncheon.

Information to be included in application

1. Attach three typed narratives, 300 words or less each, that address the following:
 - a. Describe the community service activity that was conducted and who benefitted from the activity. Was this a new or ongoing activity?
 - b. What was the impact or results of the community service activity?
 - c. Who else was involved? Explain or describe their contribution.
2. No additional pages of information, photos, and/or news clippings should be included. The application is limited to a maximum of 4-pages single-sided.

Award and Presentation Details

An "Award Announcement Letter" listing the award recipients, will be sent to County Extension offices in early January. Extension professionals can then personally notify award recipients.

All award recipients will receive personal invitations to the Ohio 4-H Volunteer Recognition Luncheon directly from the State 4-H Office in early February. Each award recipient will receive an award during the luncheon at the Ohio 4-H Conference.
